

# 2007-2008 JISD Dress Code

The District's Dress Code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, instill discipline, prevent disruption, avoid safety hazards and teach respect for authority. Student dress reflects the quality of the school and effects students' conduct. Students shall be dressed and groomed in a manner that is clean, neat and that will not be a health or safety hazard to themselves or others. Any article of clothing, jewelry, body decoration or hairstyle extreme enough to create a distraction or disturb the normal routine of school shall be deemed inappropriate. The district prohibits any clothing or grooming that in the campus administrator's judgment may reasonably be expected to cause disruption of or interference with normal school operations. If hygiene becomes a problem, the parent will be contacted. It is the responsibility of all school personnel to enforce the dress code.

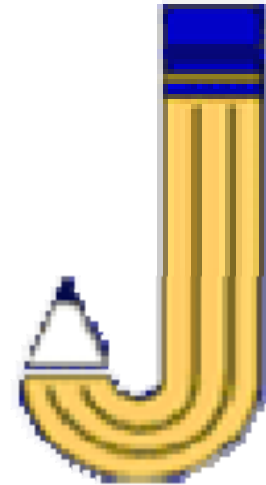
## What will this dress code do for our district?

### Shirts and Blouses

- Collared knit polo style or oxford style shirt. Short or long sleeve (No sleeveless)
- Must be solid : Blue, Yellow/Gold, White, Red, Green (No stripes, Plaids, etc.)
- Shirts and blouses must be tucked in at all times except for PK-2nd grade students, who are encouraged but not required
- No Logo or Picture unless approved JISD logo
- No exposed midriffs
- No brads, studs, rivets or decorations of any kind on clothing.
- No cleavage.
- Undershirts must be white, black or the same color as the top shirt.

### Sweatshirts, Vest, Sweaters, and Hoodies

- Must be appropriately sized in the shoulders, sleeves, and length, and must be worn over an approved shirt or blouse and collar must be visible.
- Must be solid: Blue, Yellow/Gold, White, Red, Green, Gray
- No logo or Picture unless approved JISD logo

### Pants, Shorts, Capris

- Pleated or Flat Front Cuffed or hemmed with No Logo Larger than 2"X2"
- Worn at the waistline
- Must be solid: Navy blue, Khaki, or Black
- No Denim and five pockets or less
- No Exercise Pants, Wind Pants, Cargo Pants, Painter Pants, Overalls or Sweatpants
- Pants must be worn outside the shoes
- Pants may not be cut, ripped, or have holes of any kind (belt loops, pant legs, etc.)
- No brads, studs, rivets or decorations of any kind on clothing.

### Footwear

- No house shoes
- Shoes must be a matching pair

### Skorts, Skirts and Jumpers

- Cuffed or hemmed and worn at waistline
- No Denim and no logo larger than 2"X2"
- Must be solid: Navy blue, Khaki, Black
- Skirts, skorts, shorts and jumpers must touch the top of the knee or in elementary (PK-4) must be no shorter than outstretched fingertips.

### Belts

- Belts must be worn if there are belt loops Leather-like, Dress-Style or Canvas with Buckle Buckled
- Belts must be worn within belts-loops, and must be visible and have no excessive length.
- Belts are optional for PK-2nd students

### All Fridays and Designated Spirit Days

Denim may be worn and must meet the criteria for "Pants, Shorts, Capris, Skorts, Skirts, or Jumpers" and must be accompanied by an approved shirt (criteria for "Shirts and Blouses) or an approved School Spirit T-shirt (**Spirit Days are designated by the campus administrator.**)

### Recommended but Not Required

#### Footwear

- Athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes or other closed-toed shoes
- Heels no greater than 1 1/2 inches in height

#### Outerwear

- Jackets/Coats not to have logos and pictures.

### Other Guidelines

- Top and bottom cannot be same color (e.g., blue pant and blue shirt)
- No excessively loose clothing.
- No over-sized clothing.
- No form-fitting clothing.

### Other Guidelines Continued

- No long coats reaching below mid-thigh.
- No symbols, words or slogans, lines, designs, numbers, designs, numbers, etc. are to be cut in the hair or eyebrow.
- Symbols on clothing or jewelry, including chains, collars, or bracelets, that would distract (racially related, offensive or provocative symbols, emblems, pictures, words, slogans or tattoos). Excessive use of safety pins is not permitted.
- No distracting make-up, hair color, or hair styles.
- Hair color must be a natural shade.
- Well groomed facial hair is permissible.
- No ponytails on boys.
- Boys' hair length in back must be worn so that it is no longer than the top of the collar.
- Boys' hair in front must be no longer than the top of the eyebrow with the sides no longer than the bottom of the earlobe.
- No exposed body piercings except for earrings. No earrings for boys.
- No grills or other objects covering teeth.
- Students in D.I.R.E.C.T. must wear approved pants and approved white shirts every day.

### Final Authority

Students must comply with district standards for grooming and accessories as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct. Final decisions on the appropriateness of school dress rest with the campus administration.

### Consequences

If the campus administration determines that a student's grooming violates the dress code, the student shall be given an opportunity to correct the problem at school. If the violation cannot be fixed; the student's parents or guardian will be notified and the student will not return to class until the violation is corrected. The student may also be sent home. All absences for dress code violations will be unexcused.

### New Student in JISD

Students new to the district have seven (7) calendar days from the date of enrollment to comply with the policy.
